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## ***8 Mill Street Mews***

*is a beautiful ground floor apartment for two persons, tastefully decorated and furnished. There is a comfortable sitting room with TV and DVD player; attractive dining area and kitchenette equipped with fridge (containing complimentary refreshments), electric hob, and microwave.*



*The double bedroom has a large built-in wardrobe and access to the en-suite shower room.*

*The apartment is situated within just four minutes walk to Mildenhall's town centre and all of its amenities. In terms of distance, it is less than 0.2 miles to the bus station, supermarket, market place and town centre, and just few yards further to the town car park behind the main supermarket.*



*To maintain the highest standards of cleanliness and hygiene, the apartment is strictly non-smoking throughout and pets are not allowed.*

## ***Services provided***



*All linen, towels, electricity and gas heating are included. As a self-catering apartment, it is not serviced, although we do offer fresh linen and towels for guests staying one week or longer. We will try to accommodate a reasonable amount of washing and ironing for a small charge during your stay upon request.*

*Guests are welcome to enjoy exploring the surroundings using the gents and ladies cycles located at the apartment. If you would like to use them, please speak to Robert or Tricia for the key to the cycle lock. Use of these cycles is, of course, at guest's own risk.*

*Free internet wi-fi is available in the apartment.*



## ***Guest Parking***

*During the day, one-hour parking is possible about 30 metres away from the apartment. For loading/unloading, guests are allowed to reverse into the Mews to the side entrance door, but asked to limit their parking here to a reasonable limit, as this is a shared pedestrian access to other apartments. Parking is available directly outside the apartment on Mill Street in the evenings and night-time. Free unlimited parking is available five minutes' walk away in the town car park near Sainsburys.*

## ***Arrival and departure***

*Guests may arrive after 3pm. Please telephone us one or two days before travelling to make arrangements for an introduction and to receive your key. Guests must leave by 11am on the day of departure. You will be informed where to leave the key should we be unavailable at the time.*

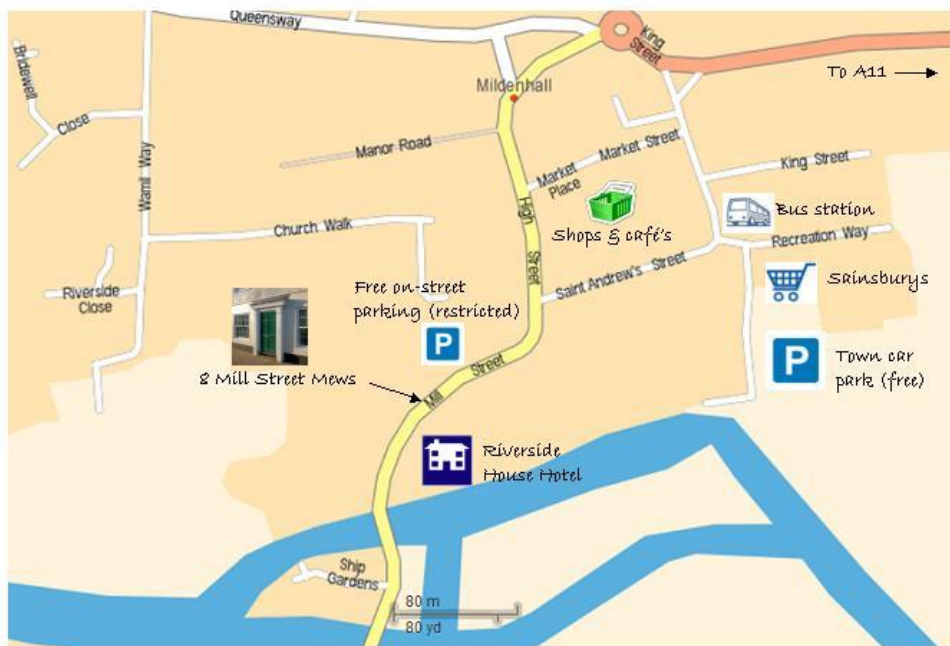
## ***Children and extra beds***

*The town centres on its historic 16th century market cross and town pump. The town's market is held here every Friday. There is a wide range of pubs, cafés, restaurants and takeaways in the town, and the small museum offers an insight to Mildenhall's prominent military history, its famous 1934 England to Australia air race and the fascinating story of the Mildenhall Treasure – the subject of a book of the same name by Roald Dahl.*

*From the apartment a 3 mile circular riverside walk or a town heritage trail are excellent ways to explore the immediate area. There's much to do in the surrounding area from horse racing in Newmarket to brewery tours in Bury St Edmunds. A wealth of tourist information can be found in the apartment.*
